Develop our locational knowledge by:

- naming and locating our local town.
- naming, locating and identifying characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.
- naming and locating the world's seven continents and five oceans.

Develop our place knowledge by:

- understanding geographical similarities and differences, by looking at the human and physical geography of a small area of the United Kingdom and of a small area in a contrasting non-European country.

Develop our human and physical geography by:

- identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world, in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
- use geographical vocabulary to talk about physical features, including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.
